

## First Chronicles discussion questions:

1. David had some real spiritual giants in his genealogy. He also had some real rascals. What has played a bigger role in your life, the physical or spiritual genealogy? Who are some of the people who have helped you grow spiritually?
2. What kind of spiritual legacy are you leaving for the next two generations?
3. Look at 1 Chron. 16:8-36. What are the key elements of this song that we should translate into our prayers?
4. In chapter 17, God makes a covenant (promise) with David. What is the covenant and how long will it last? [This covenant was also in 2 Samuel 7:18-29. The covenant is that God will establish a kingdom through David and his descendants. It will be forever. This is fulfilled ultimately through Jesus Christ.]
5. Review 28:9, 10, 20. What can we learn from this: 1) Know God personally; 2) Serve God whole-heartedly; 3) Serve God willingly; 4) Seek God and his will; 5) Be faithful to God; 6) Be careful and do whatever God has called you to do. 6) Be strong and courageous.
6. Because God has been faithful and true in the past, we can count on the same from him in the future. Discuss.
