1 Samuel chapters 16-24

Chapter 16

Review the events in *Chpt.15* and the Lord's rejection of Saul as king. Discuss the significance of the Lord sending (*anointing*) His choice of king from the sons of Jesse.

Did God "send" and evil spirit to torment Saul, or did He allow evil to enter once His Holy Spirit departed?

Chapter 17

Enter...David! See Ephesians 6:10-18, how does this verse relate to events surrounding David and Goliath?

Chapter 18

What is the benefit of yoking/aligning ourselves to other Christians as Jonathan did with David?

<u>Chapter 19-20</u>

Share how Jonathan and David formed a new covenant to the Lord during the New Moon festival. (v. 42) (Note: The New Moon festival was celebrated differently by the Israelites versus other nations...similar to the difference between the *anointed* kings of Israel and those of other nations)

<u>Chapter 21-22</u>

Was Ahimelech wrong in giving David consecrated bread? Was David disobedient to God by consuming it?

Was David's deception sinful when he posed as a "madman" to escape the wrath of the Philistines?

Chapter 23-24

Did Saul's confession of wrong doing to David absolve him in the eyes of God? What was David's reasoning in saving Saul's life?
