4. Ch. 18 - Why do people think a lie is better to hear than the truth?
5. How does Elijah's name "My God is LORD" relate to the showdown with the prophets of Baal? How do you think this impacted the people of Israel in the days to come? What are your key takeaways from the showdown between Elijah and the prophets of Baal and Asherah?
6. Were you surprised at how God dealt with Elijah when he was depressed/ discouraged? What applications can this have in our lives?
7. What are the key ways you have seen the faithfulness of God in 1 Kings?
