Small Group Questions for 2 Kings 1-6

- 1. Why does Elijah call down fire from heaven to consume people who oppose him and his God?
- 2. How does Elijah foreshadow John the Baptist?
- 3. Who are the only people mentioned in the Bible who are taken to heaven without dying? (Enoch Gen. 5:21-24; Hebrews 11:5-6; Elijah 2 Kings 2:9-10) Do you think about what your exit from this world might look like?
- 4.2 Kings 4:1-7 tells of a woman who was not able to pay her bills. How did God supply her needs according to her faith and obedience? Is there a lesson in that for us?
- 5.2 Kings 4:8-17 tells of a woman who was richly blessed. She was also hospitable and generous to Elijah. Are you hospitable to your pastor or someone who is doing the work of the LORD?
- 6. Chapter 5 tells us about a man, Naaman who had leprosy. How was he healed? Did he come to God on his own terms or on God's? How do you approach God?
- 7. In Chapter 6 we see a whole host of God's army show up to protect Elisha and his servant. Have you ever felt that there was an unseen angel or group of angels protecting you?
