

2 Kings 15-20 Questions:

1. If God were to write a 1-2 sentence summary of your life, what would it be? (You have to use the word good or evil. You also have to include if you served God with all your heart or not.)
2. Do you think any of the evil kings of Israel would have described themselves as evil?
3. King Ahaz in ch. 16 wanted a new altar and a new way of doing worship in Jerusalem. He wanted to copy the altar at Damascus. Do we see churches today that want to copy the ways of the world for worship in our churches? Can you think of examples?
4. Chapter 17 reviews all the reasons that Israel fell into captivity. Are we guilty of any of these today? What was the main cause? What idols are we worshipping?
5. Because Hezekiah was a man of prayer and strong faith, Judah did not fall to the Assyrians. We need to pray that our national and world leaders are people of prayer and faith. But we need to personalize that even more into our households. We need to be women of faith who pray for our homes and families so that they do not fall into enemy hands.
