2. Are all of our sins and problems brought on by sinfulness?

3. Elijah was taken to heaven on chariots of fire and Elisha got sick and died. Does that mean that God loved Elijah more? Ideally, how would you like to pass from this world?

4. Were the kings a reflection of the nation - good or bad - or was it the nation that was a reflection of the king? How does that translate to today and our leaders.
