Who was Onesiphorus and what is he known for?

Write out and meditate on “the trustworthy saying” in 2 Timothy:11-13.

How should God's truth be taught?

Application: (In other words, how do I apply this to my life?)

Why was Paul suffering? Are you anxious to join Paul in suffering for the gospel? What does purpose does suffering serve? How has suffering affected your faith?

After some reflection, how do Paul's comparisons to soldiers, athletes and farmers apply to your life?

What kind of articles do you have in your house and which ones do you use to cleanse yourself? In what ways does that make you useful to the Master?
