

Daniel Chapters 8-9 questions:

1. How does Daniel's vision in chapter 8 compare with his vision in chapter 7?
2. We have seen that Daniel was a man of faith, courage, and character. He is a person who studied and believed the Scriptures. Read 9:2. What did he understand was about to take place from his reading from Jeremiah?
3. We also know that he prayed; that's why he was thrown in the lion's den. 6:10b says, "**Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before.**" In 9:4-20, we can read one of his beautiful prayers. Notice how much of his prayer is spent praising God and confessing sin on behalf of himself and his people. Very little of his prayer is asking God for anything, and even then, it is very unselfish. What are some things we can learn from this?
4. How was Daniel's prayer interrupted? Have you ever had a prayer answered before you even finished praying or very soon afterwards?
5. What is the main thing you can take from chapters 8-9?
