Ex 10:

How could God reward a humble heart? (Ex 10:3)

What was God's purpose in the hardening of Pharaoh's heart?

Did Pharaoh truly want to repent each time he confessed that he had sinned? (during each plague)

Ex 11:

Why didn't Pharaoh just have Moses killed or imprisoned?

How did Moses regain his stature within the Egyptian community?

How did this help him lead the exodus?

Ex 12:

Why was it important for God to give specific instructions on how to distribute the blood of the lambs?

What was the significance of God's instruction on preparing the Passover meals and eating it in haste? (Ex. 12:11)

Who might the "aliens" have been and could they have converted or joined the Exodus?

Reflection:

Pharaoh tried compromising the level of obedience that God had instructed Moses and the Israelites to follow. What does God want from you? Are you "all in"- self, family, finances, and possessions? Or have you put up a few conditions?

See the numbers in (Ex. 12:14-16) God's perfection, the number 7 and multiples of 7. (Ex. 12:17-20)

God knew the Israelites would not always stay in one region. What provision did he make?

How can we pass down our faith experiences to future generations?

Have you covered your life with the blood, the blood of Jesus?
