In verse 14, what finally made God burn with anger?

What is going on in v24-26?

Chapter 5:

Describe the immediate consequences after Moses spoke to Pharaoh.

Who did the Israelites cry out to? What was the response they were given?

Who did they blame for their troubles and why was this misguided?

Was it ok for Moses to complain to God in verses 22-23? What does he do right and where is he off-track? (refer to 4:21)

Chapter 6:

List the 7 things God promises to do in verses 6-8:

Why would God allow any struggle when it was His idea to free the Israelites?

What is meant when Moses said he speaks with "faltering" {uncircumcised} lips in both verses 12 and 30?

Reflection:

Is it easy or hard to walk in God's will for your life?

Things became much worse for the Israelites before they got any better. Are you able to 'keep the faith' even when things don't appear to be going well and you believe you're doing what God wants you to do?
