

Ezekiel chapters 37-48 group questions:

Before getting to my questions each week, ask the group if there is something from the lesson that they would like to comment on concerning the lesson. (They may come in fired up about something that was said and I might not have a question that gives them the opportunity to express that.)

1. Discuss the dry bones coming to life in chapter 37. Have you ever experienced a time when you felt all dry and dead inside? Does anyone feel that way now? If so, know that God wants to breathe new life into you, and give you a new heart and fill it with His Holy Spirit.
2. In chapters 40-48, God gives Ezekiel visions of the Lord and a new temple. Whether this vision is literal or symbolic, this gave hope to the people who had seen the nation fall and the temple destroyed.
3. Thinking back over the whole book of Ezekiel, which of his visions, sermons, or parables most caught your interest? Why? (Take a few minutes to flip back through the pages of Ezekiel to refresh their memories.)
4. What has the book of Ezekiel taught you about God?
5. Has Ezekiel taught you anything about yourself? Do you see the sovereignty of God in your personal life?
