Compare Cain's lineage to Seth's lineage. (chapter's 4 & 5)

### Reflection:

What do these chapters reveal about God?

Is there a difference in wanting to be God-like or like God? Are either wrong?

Is it possible to avoid temptation? Where does sin begin?

In what ways can God's word be misused? And what is the result when His word is misused?

What is the attitude of *my* heart when I'm worshipping? Serving? Giving to God?

How do the differences in Seth and Cain's lineages demonstrate the importance of our first mission field being our homes and families?
