

Isaiah 21-33 Discussion Questions

1. In what ways have you put your trust in the government, structures, and institutions of your life? Have you ever considered that God, in His justice, might destroy your city or home country one day? Does this motivate you to take action?

2. What major world or national event during your lifetime shocked you the most? Did it impact the way you think about your relationship with God? How did it impact the worldview of others in your life?

3. Many passages in the Bible, like Isaiah 25:6 talk about feasting and foods. Some compare this to the Wedding feast of the Lamb in Rev. 19:6-9. In fact, food is all throughout the Bible from beginning to end. Where are some other scriptures where we find food in the Bible? What meal celebrations do you remember most fondly?

4. Isaiah 25:8 also has a complimentary passage in the NT. Can you find it? (Rev. 21)

5. When you face a difficult situation, is your default to turn to God and trust Him with the circumstances first? Why or why not?

6. When have you seen God's unseen hand at work protecting you in your life? How did that event impact your faith and how you lived it out?
