2. Isaiah 35 is full of joy, singing and gladness. How does our obedience lead to a more joyful life?
3. Isaiah 36-39 give us a pretty good snapshot of King Hezekiah's life. What were his high and low points?
4. Isaiah 40 is a turning point in the book of Isaiah that compares with the New Testament. Many of these verses are often quoted. What is your favorite verse(s) from this chapter? Why?
5. Isaiah 41-44 gives prophecies, hope and warning to Israel. How would you summarize these chapters?
