

Isaiah 45-53 Discussion Questions

1. Isaiah 45 is a prophecy about a king named Cyrus who will rule Persia about 150 years later. Does history prove this to be true? Who does Cyrus foreshadow and how?

2. Read Isaiah 45:5-6 and 46:9-10. Why does God need to keep reminding his people that there is only one God and he is the LORD? Do we need to be reminded of this?

3. Chapters 49-50 speak of the coming Messiah and the restoration of Israel. What are some key verses you see here?

4. Isaiah 52:13 through 53:12 are often referred to as "The Suffering Servant" . Do you see how Christ's crucifixion is foreshadowed in these verses.

5. Is God's love for you sometimes revealed in unexpected ways? If so, how?
