Joshua 1-5 Questions

<u>Joshua 1:</u>

How can we view prosperity in terms of being strong and courageous? (Ps. 1:1-3)

What must we do when faced with new leadership over us?

<u>Joshua 2:</u>

Is there ever a time when lying is justified?

Discuss the significance of the "scarlet cord" Rahab hung in her window and the foreshadowing of Jesus.

<u>Joshua 3-4:</u>

Share the typology of the Lord's instruction to Joshua "chose 12 men...12 stones..." (4:2-3)

How important are physical memorials to future generations? How long should they be preserved?

<u>Joshua: 5:</u>

See (5:9) and discuss the symbolic importance of the Lord's instruction to Joshua: "...Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you....."

Reflection:

Identify a time where you crossed from old ways into new through your faith

Are our current times as defining as when the Israelites entered Canaan?

What tools do you have for coping with situations/events beyond your control? Would it be helpful to share these with others?
