Joshua 6

Does your faithfulness last when waiting for answers to prayer?

In what ways can we purge evil and clutter (physical/mental) and *devote* ourselves to the Lord?

Joshua 7

Discuss the sometimes mis-interpreted instances of plundering when God instructed the overtaking of corrupt cities.

Are we steadfast in our belief when guiding others even if it divides us in that relationship?

Joshua 8-9

When we veer off course from God's instruction, how can we correct ourselves in the future? (Eph 6:18)

Joshua 10-12

What justifies war? Why is keeping detailed records of battles/outcomes important?

Reflection:

Do we keep our attention fixed on God, giving Him the praise instead of ourselves? (Proverbs 3:6-7)

What does your daily compass look like? How can you keep it pointed toward the Lord?

Today, can we commit a time each day to stop and listen to God's silent instruction? (Heb 3:15)
