Comprehension

1. Where do these chapters take place?
2. What are the topics of Jesus' teachings throughout these two chapters?

Interpretation

3. In Luke 13:6, Jesus tells a parable about a fig tree that had no fruit. How can you tell if you are bearing fruit? How do we bear fruit?
4. We are told in Luke 13:24-30 to make every effort to enter through the narrow door. How can we do this? Who is the owner of the house? Why will he refuse entry to people?

Application

5. Luke discusses the cost of being a disciple in Luke 14:25-35. What has it cost you to be his disciple? How is God calling you to follow Him in this season of your life?
6. When was the last time you invited someone who was really in need to dine with you? For most of us, that happens rarely, if at all. Why? What should we do about it? This week would you pray for God to place someone on your heart to invite over?
