## Comprehension

2. Retell the parable of the four soils in Luke 8. How does this parable relate to us and what does it teach us about God?

## Interpretation

- 3. In Luke 9:28-36 Jesus takes Peter, James and John up onto a mountain to pray. Jesus' appearance changes and Moses and Elijah appear with him. What is Peter's response when He sees Jesus like this? What should our response be when Jesus reveals Himself to us? What lessons can we take away from this story?
- 4. In Luke 10:17-24 we see the disciples sharing their joy and triumphs to Jesus after they return from being sent to the towns ahead of Him. He shares in their joy, but also reminds them to make sure to remember the most important thing. What does He tell them is the true victory and how does He warn them?

## Application

5. In Luke 8:38, the man whom the demons had gone out begged to go with Jesus, but He sent him away, saying "Return home and tell how much God has done for you." We need to always be prepared to share what God has done for us. What has the Lord done for you?

6. What did you learn from the Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37 and who is your neighbor? What is one way you can love your neighbors this week? Write a prayer asking the Lord to open your eyes to who your neighbor is and ask Him to help your heart be willing to love them how He calls you to.
