## **Chapter 3:**

**Comprehension** – What stood out to you in this chapter?

### Interpretation

In verse 12 Peter humbly, yet boldly shares his faith. He completely calls all who are listening out on their part in Jesus' death – but is it left there? What action does he encourage them to take in order to wipe out their sins?

Why does Peter always mention the resurrection?

### **Application**

Do you believe that God still heals through the power of the Holy Spirit? Why or why not? Do you believe in the name of Jesus as boldly/strongly as Peter?

Peter is able to quote the word of God easily? How can he do it? Are you able to quote God's word?

# **Chapter 4:**

**Comprehension** – What stood out to you in this chapter?

### Interpretation

Peter is really shining in these chapters, what do you attribute this major change in his life to?

What is more important, to be right by God or right by men?

It is striking that they pray for the ability to speak with great boldness, rather than changed circumstances. Can you wrap your head around that? Is it okay to pray for both?

### **Application**

"...they took note that these men had been with Jesus." verse 13, do you think anyone in your life has ever taken note of the fact that you spend time with Jesus?
