HEBREWS 6 & 7

Comprehension: (In other words, what does it say?) Focus of chapters 6 and 7?
Interpretation: (In other words, what does it mean?) Discuss the differences between elementary teachings and maturity:
Abraham was patient? What things are you able to understand about who God is based on 6:10-20?
What is the significance of Jesus entering the inner sanctuary on our behalf?
Who is Melchizedek the Priest and what is his relevance? How is Jesus part of this order of priesthood and what sets him apart from all other high priests?
What are the characteristics of God we see in these two chapters?
Application: (In other words, how do I apply this to my life?) Hebrews 6:12 says "We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised." Other than attending Merry Ministries weekly (yay!), are you staying active in God's kingdom work and not becoming lazy (personal reflection question, no need to make a list for us!)? Retirement is a big deal in our culture, is there such a thing as "active faith" retirement? What does an "active faith" look like?
