

Small Group Discussion Questions

First ask if anyone took the challenge to share their faith this week. Let them share briefly and then go to the questions.

1. Romans 1:18-23

* **Comprehension:** (In other words, What does it say?)

What is the wrath of God against? (v.18)

How does God make Himself known to all people? (vv. 19-20)

what two things does God reveal about Himself (v. 20)

Do all people receive that knowledge? (v.21-23)

* **Interpretation: (In other words, What does it mean?)**

How would you paraphrase these verses?

* **Application:** (In other words, How do I apply this to my life?)

When you truly know God, what should your response to Him be? (v. 21 - glorify Him and give Him thanks)

2. Romans 1:24-32

* **Comprehension:** (In other words, What does it say?)

When we exchange glorifying God and believing lies rather than the truth, what takes place? (v. 26-32)

What sins are listed here?

* **Interpretation: (In other words, What does it mean?)**

What do we learn about God in these verses?

What do we learn about sin?

* **Application:** (In other words, How do I apply this to my life?)

What excuses do we use to justify our sins? Knowing how God feels about my sins, what should my response to God be?

3. Romans 2:1-11

* **Comprehension:** What is Paul expressing in these verses concerning judgment and condemnation of others? How can we know right from wrong? Who is the ultimate judge?

* **Interpretation:** How would you paraphrase his words? How is identifying sin different from judging sin?

* **Application:** Since God's laws are clearly available to me in His written Word, the Bible, and because they are seen throughout creation, what kind of life should I be living?
