**Comprehension:** (In other words, what does it say?)

**Interpretation:** (In other words, what does it mean?)

Why was Titus in Crete? How are the Cretans described?

What is said about eternal life? How was God's word manifested?

Compare both the negative/positive qualifications required to be an elder in the church. Explain the purpose behind the requirements. Is there a distinction between elders and bishops?

What type of people did Paul warn against? What kind of damage were they causing? What was Paul's instruction on how to deal with them?

What type of doctrine should be taught? How are the different groups of people instructed to live?
